How can I get my child signed up?

Parents considering getting their children involved in the exciting world of entertainment can complete the ONLINE APPLICATION form to let us know you're interested. From here we will send you further information and you can get all of your questions answered and sign up for time for your photo shoot.

What happens at the Photo shoot/Interview Day

CTM Management's experienced staff will explain what makes the industry 'tick', how they as an agency work and provide feedback about current opportunities within the industry. Their expertise in selecting an appropriate number of talent across all categories, ensures clients return to the agency as they know they make suitable selections for a variety of requests. Not only will they have great talent on their books, but they also have the experience to effectively handle all the necessary permits and booking logistics, making it easy for their clients to deal with. What are the Rates Of Pay?

Rates can vary according to certain clients and different roles. Generally, Photographic and Catalogue work starts at \$95 per hour while TV Commercials, TV Series and Feature Films can start at \$25 per hour and range up to \$25,000. Each job is different depending on the role or how prominently you feature, for example as an extra, featured extra, featured or a speaking role.

Loading fees may also apply and can start at \$100 and range up to \$18,000. This is for additional use such as billboards, in store posters, packaging or international use and can occur weeks or even months after the job.

How will CTM Management find my child work?

Goodhew talent will be placed on both Casting Networks and AT2, which are the two leading on-line casting services. It is CTMs job to find their clients work and is in their best interest to have their talent out there in the industry as much as possible.

Is there any guarantee that my child will get job offers?

No agency can guarantee work. The role of an agency is to be the mediator between the talent (you) and the client. It will always be the client's decision to select who they would like to see for a casting, and who they would like to book for a job. However, CTM will only submit people who they feel are the most appropriate for a role, therefore increasing your chances of getting the job.

How do I know that CTM are a reputable agency?
